6. What kind of information about me is processed?

The survey is answered anonymously. The personal information collected is the country and position of the respondent in the organization.

The survey is sent to respondents via EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES CONTINUING EDUCATION NETWORK (EUCEN). The personal data of the respondents will not come to the attention of the analysts of the survey.
